The Milk Snake



Where can you find them?

-  Areas of forest
-  Open prairies
-  Rocky slopes

What do they eat?

-  Mostly rodents
-  Insects/slugs
-  Lizards
-  Earthworms
-  They don't drink milk!

What about their young?

Milk snakes lay eggs, and the number depends on where they live. They mate from early May to late June. They lay their eggs beneath logs, rocks, and rotting plants. They don't hatch for 2 months. They live for around 12 years!
