Explorer Camp

Age: 5 – 7 years old

Dates: **June 16, 17, 18** from 9 – 1 each day

Theme: Nature Detectives

Flowers, trees, bugs, animals, water—there is so much to see, do, and learn about—join us in exploring the natural world!

Ranger Camp

Age: 8 – 10 years old

Dates: **July 14, 15, 16** from 9 – 1 each day
