3-day Hurstville Center Camps:

Explorer Camp Theme: *Growing Up Wild*
June 10, 11, 12 (Tues, Wed, Thurs) from 9:00 – 2:00
 At the Hurstville Interpretive Center. For youth entering Kdg-1st grade next fall; Cost: \$35. *Participants will enjoy activities while learning about nature, wildlife and Iowa's habitats. Maquoketa Art Experience will lead an art project 1 hour each day.*

Ranger Camp Theme: *Iowa's Natural Resources*
June 17, 18, 19 (Tues, Wed, Thurs) from 9:00 – 2:00
 At the Hurstville Interpretive Center. For youth entering 2nd–4th grade next fall; Cost: \$35. *Participants will enjoy games and activities while learning about our local natural resources. Maquoketa Art Experience will lead an art project 1 hour each day.*

Adventure Camp Theme: *Outdoor Recreation*
June 24, 25, 26 (Tues, Wed, Thurs) from 9:00 – 3:00
 We'll start at the Hurstville Center each day. For youth entering 5th–8th grade next fall. Cost: \$60. *Participants will enjoy canoeing/kayaking, fishing, orienteering, outdoor cooking and a variety of other outdoor recreation activities. Transportation to another park one day will be provided by RTA. Maquoketa Art Experience will lead an art project one day.*
